Change to Crewsaver operating Head torque wrench 10465

Note:-

The supplier of the calibrated torque wrench part code 10465 has stopped manufacture to this item.

This has been replaced by a new version of the torque wrench and a T-Bar.

They will be supplied under the same Part code. (10465)

The T-bar replaces the welded ¼ drive point on the head of the old tool, that was used to remove the nut from the UML and HR Heads.







The New version tool is supplied with the modified socket which is required when removing the UML operating Heads (this must be used as a Standard socket can damage the nut.)

Single socket code R47241




Modified socket
