Instruction for replacing a recessed light on a Crewsaver Premier lifejacket.

Note:- only approved lights can be fitted to this product to meet the SOLAS approvals required on this jacket.

Universal Light housing/Adaptor without manual switch



Place the lifejacket on a clean flat surface (Face up) Place the tip of the flat blade screwdriver into each on the points highlighted with a , (one at a time) unclip the light adaptor from the housing by turning it clockwise





The Light and the adaptor will then lift out of the housing.





The Light can be released from the adaptor by unclipping it from the jaws on the side of the light (Marked in the image by 1)















Place the new light into the adaptor, push on until its "clicks" in to place on the side of the light from the jaws on (Marked in the image by 1)





Place the new light and adaptor back into the housing, line up and push down until its "clicks" in to place

Universal Light housing/Adaptor with manual switch

The Light and the adaptor will then lift out of the housing.

The Light can be released from the adaptor by unclipping it from the jaws on the side of the light (Marked in the image by 1)







Place the new light into the adaptor, push on until it "clicks" in to place on the side of the light from the jaws on (Marked in the image by 1)
Ensure that the orange switch on the adaptor lines up with the orange switch





Place the new light and adaptor back into the housing, line up and push down until it "clicks" in to place



Test the new light by pressing the (orange) on/off button on the adaptor.
